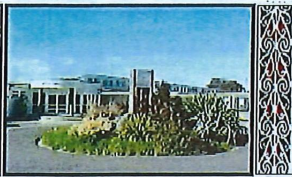
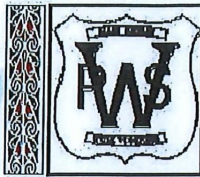

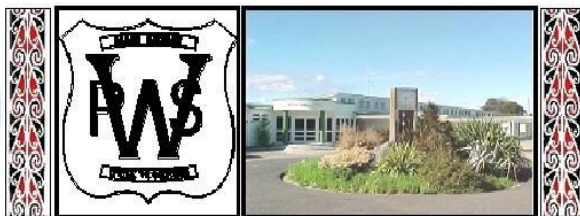

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PEPEHA

Part of the kaupapa (way we do things) at our kura(school) is to encourage the children to be proud of their background and heritage by knowing their pepeha. (Pepeha is a way of introducing yourself in Māori. It tells people who you are by sharing your connections with the people and places that are important to you.)

Every year we cover this and to help us we would like to keep a copy of this information so each year the class teachers are not requesting the same info from you over and over again. The pepeha is a way of introducing ourselves. It ties us to our tipuna (ancestors), acknowledges and respects our families and heritage.

If you are Maori your pepeha is based on your whanau and how they first came to New Zealand.

If you are from another culture your pepeha represents your journey. You may wish to acknowledge how your family first came to New Zealand or you may wish to celebrate your cultural roots in another way. An example of this is if you are European and your family came to New Zealand many generations ago, you may know the name of the boat they travelled to New Zealand on then that becomes your waka. If you are new to New Zealand and flew here on Air New Zealand then that may be your waka. If you were American and your family came there on the Mayflower this might be part of your heritage you wish to acknowledge. Your mountain and river may be the ones where you live now or you could choose the most significant ones from where you are from. You may not have a Marae but you may have a place where you gather with others it could be a religious place, a place of business or a school.

You can also leave any blank or talk to one of the staff at school if you have any questions.

Free Healthy School Lunches

We are pleased that the Government is focusing on child wellbeing by offering to trial 'Free Healthy School Lunches' at Wairoa Primary, beginning Term One 2020 – we have gladly accepted!
